The city of Davao which is approximately 588 miles (964 Kms) south east of Manila is the largest city in the Island of Mindanao. It is also one of the several cities of Philippines that are independent of any province. It has a population of 1,530,365 (Census 2011) making it the country's largest city outside Metro Manila and the second overall with the cities of Metro Manila combined. It has been awarded by the Department of Tourism as the best of **livable cities in the Philippines** in 2008. An estimated number of 4 million people are present in the city during the day time and it is the only city to hit the million mark outside Metro Manila since 1995 making it the second largest city.
Geography & Climate : The climate all through the year is salubrious and ranges from 20-32 degrees celsius and the average rainfall is up to 2000 mm yearly. **Hence the climate is tropical and is similar to India.**
Davao City is typhoon free. The city enjoys a weather that remains balmy all year round. It is characterized by a uniform distribution of rainfall, temperature, humidity and air pressure. It has no pronounced wet or dry season.

Travel & Transportation

Davao City is easily accessible. It has direct international air connectivity from Singapore, Malaysia, Hong-Kong and Bangkok. It also has regular air, sea and land linkages to major points in the country.
